IN COMPLIANCE with the requirements of Florida Statutes, Chapter 607, the undersigned, being a natural person, does hereby act as an incorporator in adopting and filing the following Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of organizing business corporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is:
