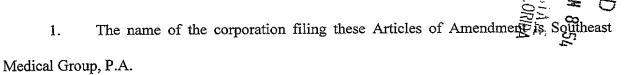

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF SOUTHEAST MEDICAL GROUP, P.A.

(Changing business purpose from the rendering of professional services

to
any lawful purpose
and
changing corporate name
from

to
SOMEDICAL, INC.)



2. The text of the amendments to the Articles of Incorporation of Southeast Medical Group, P.A. are as follows:
