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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

I, the undersigned natural person of the age of eighteen years or more, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE 1

If the Florida Business Corporation Act, or other applicable law is amended to authorize corporate action further eliminating or limiting the liability of directors, then the liability of a director of the corporation Act, or other applicable law, as so amended.

Any repeal or modification of the foregoing paragraph by the shareholders shall not adversely affect any right or protection of a director existing at the time of such repeal or modification.
