

To Whom This May Concern,

I am applying for reinstatement of my corporation and I wanted to explain why it ended up dissolved. I am a new business owner, it is my first time dealing with the administration of a corporation. When I looked on your web site and saw that my corporation was dissolved, I realized that my old address was the one you had on file. I am assuming that the year end annual summary report (that I have since learned needed to be filled out) was to be mailed there. I had no guidance that I was to fill this type of report out, and did not in any way purposely neglect the state of any information about my corporation. I did know, through the advice of my accountant, that I needed to change the address with the state, what I failed to recognize was that by changing the address with the Department of Revenue, I was not telling everyone that needed to know about the change. I was under the impression that if the tax department had my address, everyone else would. It is clearly my mistake, I just did not know any better. When I called the Division of Corporations, I was instructed to request a reinstatement application and to send a letter explaining what had happened. Please find the attached application.

I am asking for a pardon of the penalty fees, as I did not know what I was doing wrong. I am, however, including the 300.00 that is due for the renewal of my corporation for the last two years. Please advise me if my request has been accepted, and what else I need to do to have the corporation reinstated.
