ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

ALLABOUT GLASS INC.

The undersigned incorporator files these Articles of Incorporation in order to form a corporation under the Florida Professional Service Corporation Act.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is All About Glass INC.

ARTICLE II

DURATION OF THE CORPORATION

This corporation shall exist perpetually unless dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE III
