The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE ONE - NAME AND MAILING ADDRESS

The name of the Corporation is . The mailing address for the corporation is P.O. Box 873, Crystal Beach, Florida 34681.

ARTICLE TWO - TERM OF EXISTENCE

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE THREE - PURPOSE

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized are:

- A. To operate McDonald's franchises.
