Articles of Incorporation

of

Janitorial Services of South Florida, Inc.

The undersigned natural persons, having capacity to contract and acting as the incorporator of this Corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such Corporation, to-wit:

ARTICLE ONE: NAME & MAILING ADDRESS OF CORPORATION

The name of the Corporation is:

Janitorial Services of South Florida, Inc.

ARTICLE TWO: COMMENCEMENT AND DURATION

The corporation is to commence its existence upon the filing of these Articles by the Department of State, and will exist perpetually thereafter unless earlier dissolved in the manner prescribed by law.

ARTICLE THREE: PURPOSE AND POWERS

The purpose of the corporation is to engage in, for profit, as a janitorial, cleaning, and maintenance service or any lawful act and activity for which corporations may be organized

under the Florida General Corporation Act, and the Corporation shall have such powers as is necessary to effectuate the practice of operating a cleaning and janitorial service in the State of Florida and their marketing of such services.

ARTICLE FOUR: CAPITAL STOCK

1. The maximum number of shares which the Corporation shall have the authority to issue is One Hundred (100 shares of Common Stock at One Dollar (\$1.00) per share par value.
2. The consideration to be paid for each share shall be payable in lawful money or property, labor, or services.

ARTICLE FIVE: PREEMPTIVE RIGHTS

The shareholders of any class or series of stock of the Corporation shall have the preemptive right to subscribe, in proportion to their holdings (rounded to the nearest full share) at the price it is offered to others, for any authorized but unissued or treasury stock of such class or series of the Corporation to be issued.

ARTICLE SIX: BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The activities and affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors, the number of members of which shall be such as from time to time shall be fixed by the By-laws of the Corporation; but in no event shall the number be less than one (1). The Board of Directors is expressly authorized to make, alter, or repeal the By-laws of the Corporation. The initial Board of directors shall consist of one (1) directors(s), whose name and address is as follows:

ARTICLE SEVEN: INDEMNIFICATION

The Corporation shall have the power to enter into an indemnity agreement with any officer or director, or any former officer or director, indemnifying the same to the full extent permitted by law.

ARTICLE EIGHT: INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT AND OFFICE

The initial registered agent of the Corporation, and the street address of the initial registered office of the Corporation in the State of Florida is:

ARTICLE NINE: INCORPORATOR


ARTICLE TEN: RESERVED POWERS

The Corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change or repeal any provision contained in these Articles of Incorporation in the manner now or hereafter prescribed by the laws of the State of Florida; and all rights and powers conferred on directors or shareholders herein are granted subject to this reservation.

ARTICLE ELEVEN: INFORMAL DIRECTOR ACTION

If all the directors severally or collectively consent in writing to any action taken or to be taken by the corporation, and the writings evidencing their consent are filed with the Secretary of the Corporation, the action shall be as valid as though it had been authorized at a meeting of the Board of Directors.

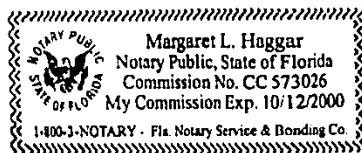
