ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

ADVICE & CONSENT, INC.

The undersigned, acting as the sole Incorporator of a Corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such Corporation:

ARTICLE I

NAME AND ADDRESS

The name of the Corporation is Advice & Consent, Inc. The address of the Corporation is 467 U.S. 27 North, Lake Placid, Florida 33852.
