ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

W.J. RICHEY & ASSOCIATES, P.A.

BILLAHASSEE, FLOW

ARTICLE I. NAME

The Name of the Professional Association shall be W.J. RICHEY & ASSOCIATES, P.A..

The name of the Professional Association may be amended from time to time as provided for in the By-Laws of the Professional Association.

ARTICLE II. DURATION

The duration of the Professional Association shall be perpetual, unless sooner dissolved as provided for in the By-Laws of the Professional Association. Corporate existence shall commence upon the filing of these Articles of Incorporation by the Department of State, State of Florida.

ARTICLE III. PURPOSE

The general purposes for which this Professional Association is initially authorized shall include:

the transaction of any or all lawful business for which a Professional Association may be incorporated under Florida Statutes, Chapter 607.

ARTICLE IV. SHARES

All initially issued shares of stock of the Professional Association shall be common voting stock. The aggregate number of share of stock which the Professional Association shall have the authority to issue shall be 1,000 shares each having a par value of \$.01.

ARTICLE V. PRE-EMPTIVE RIGHTS

The shareholders of the Professional Association shall have pre-emptive rights in purchasing additional shares of stock of the Professional Association.

ARTICLE VII. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors of the Professional Association shall at all times contain not less than one (1) and not more than five (5) members. The current members of the Board of Directors are:

ARTICLE VIII. POWERS OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

In furtherance, and not in limitation of the powers conferred by statute, the Board of Directors is expressly authorized:

To make or alter the by-laws of the Professional Association.

To fix the amount to be reserved as working capital over and above its capital stock paid in.

To authorize and cause to be executed mortgages and liens upon the real and personal property of this Professional Association.

From time to time to determine whether and to what extent, and at what time and places, and under what consideration and regulations, the accounts and books of this Professional Association (other than stock books), or any of them, shall be open to inspection by the stockholders; and no stockholder shall have any right of inspecting any account, book or document or this Professional Association except as conferred by statute, unless authorized by a resolution of the stockholders or directors.

Pursuant to the affirmative vote of the stockholders of record holding stock in the Professional Association entitling them to exercise at least a majority of the voting power, given at a stockholders' meeting duly called for that purpose or when authorized by the written consent of stockholders of record holding stock in the Professional Association entitling them to exercise at least a majority of the voting power, the Board of Directors shall have the power and authority at any meeting to sell, lease or exchange all of the property and assets of the Professional Association, including its goodwill and its corporate franchise, or any property or assets essential to the business of the Professional Association, upon such terms and conditions as its Board of Directors deem expedient and for the best interest of the Professional Association.

This Professional Association may in its by-laws confer powers upon its directors in addition to the foregoing and in addition to the powers and authorities expressly conveyed upon them by statute.

ARTICLE IX. AMENDMENTS

These Articles of InProfessional Association may be amended in the manner provided by law. Every amendment shall be approved by the Board of Directors, proposed by them to the stockholders, and approved at a stockholders' meeting by a majority of the stock entitled to vote thereon, unless all the directors and all of the stockholders sign a written statement manifesting their intention that a certain amendment of these Articles of InProfessional Association be made.


