The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 621, Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation shall be DEBORAH L. RUBIN, P.A.

PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS AND MAILING ADDRESS

The principal place of business and the mailing address of this corporation shall be 1260 South Federal Highway, Suite 201, Boynton Beach, Florida 33435.

PURPOSE

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:
