The undersigned acting as an Incorporator of COLUMBIA DEERING HOSPITAL AFTER

HOUR CARE CENTER, INC., under the Florida Business Corporations Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation shall be **COLUMBIA DEERING HOSPITAL AFTER HOUR CARE CENTER. INC.**

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation shall be to engage in any and all lawful business under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE III - PRINCIPAL OFFICE
