ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

The undersigned incorporator to this Articles of Incorporation, a natural person competent to contract, hereby forms a corporation for profit under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I - NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of this corporation shall be ROAD TRIP ENTERPRISES, INC.

ARTICLE II - DURATION

This corporation shall exist perpetually.

ARTICLE III - INITIAL PRINCIPAL OFFICE

ARTICLE XIII - BY-LAWS






