ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

We the undersigned, hereby make, subscribe, acknowledge and file this Certificate for the purpose of becoming 5 Corporation under of provisions of Chapter 607 of the Statutes of The State of Florida.

ARTICLE I

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this Corporation shall be as follows:
