The name of this corporation is:

ARTICLE II. PURPOSE

This corporation is organized for the purpose of engaging in any and all lawful businesses under the laws of Florida.

ARTICLE III. POWERS

- To have a corporate seal, which may be altered at pleasure, and to use the same by causing it, or a facsimile thereof, to be impressed, affixed or in any other manner reproduced.
