ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION FOR PROFESSIONAL CORPORATION RUSSELL L. BENUCHE, II, O.D., & ASSOCIATES, P.A.

The undersigned natural person, competent and licensed to practice optometry in the State of Florida, acting hereby as Incorporator for the purpose of forming a Professional Service Corporation for profit under the provisions of Section 607, Florida General Corporation Act, and Section 621, Florida Professional Service Corporation Act, of the Florida Statutes, does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

I NAME OF CORPORATION

The Name of this corporation is RUSSELL L. BENUCHE, II, O.D., & ASSOCIATES, P.A. Mailing Address 4141 South Tamiami Trail, Suite 22, Sarasota, Florida 34231

PURPOSE

The general nature and purposes of business to be transacted, promoted and carried on by the corporation are as follows:
