I am writing on behalf of three(3) small business Florida Corporation clients who yesterday advised me that 2001 Uniform Business Reports had not been timely filed. The corporations are:

I've been asked to set forth the circumstances which caused the late filing and request an abatement of the late filing penalties based on these circumstances.


All three corporations share a common officer as President and all three corporations employed the same relatively new individual, who they believed to be competent, to provide bookkeeping services, i.e., accounts receivable and payable, check writing, bank deposits, etc. This individual was responsible for opening mail as well as determining the course of needed action in correspondence received.

It is important that whoever performed this bookkeeping/correspondance function be very familiar with business practices in this country since the Office of President and the corporation shareholders are of Chinese origin and not familiar with the myriad of tax and filing compliance issues that have to be dealt with by a corporate entity doing business in the United States.

In this case this family relied on their bookkeeper to bring to their attention the receipt of correspondence from Florida and the IRS and a proposed handling necessary to operate their businesses and be in full compliance.

That reliance was thwarted yesterday when, much to my client's chagrin, all three UBR's were found filed away, intact, just as they had been received from the Division of Corporations. For whatever reason, and notwithstanding a reasonable reliance on this individual, the bookkeeper had failed to present these documents for signature or any other processing that would have allowed for your timely receipt of the UBR's. The bookkeeper is no longer working for these corporations.

Accordingly, and on the basis of the above circumstances, I am respectfully requesting that an exception be granted to the above entities for their late submission of UBR's and that late filing penalties be abated. Enclosed with this letter is a completed and signed UBR for each corporation along with the regular filing fee of \$150.

Thank you very much for your consideration of my request and I look forward to your favorable response.
