On behalf of our client, Garden Street Deli, Inc., we are forwarding the 2003 Annual Report and their check for \$150.00. We ask you to consider the following circumstances regarding the failure to file the required report in a timely manner.

Garden Street Deli, Inc., has been a client since its beginnings in 1997. The shareholders, Don and Mary Lou Carr, have been family friends since the early 1960's and clients for most of that time. We have always found them to be conscientious taxpayers and responsible business owners.

However, Mr. Don Carr experienced a rapid decline in health in 2002 leading up to his death, May 12, 2003. Mr. Carr was in the hospital for the last several weeks of his life and therefore unable to tend to the business affairs he usually handled prior to his final illness. In early 2003, Mrs. Carr, who has been largely responsible for management of the day-to-day operations of the business, was further burdened with business matters previously handled by Mr. Carr and, of course, constant trips to the hospital to see her husband of nearly sixty years. At Mrs. Carr's request, we are enclosing a copy of the death certificate as evidence of Mr. Carr's health problem he faced.

The \$600 penalty is an onerous burden for this small, family run business, especially under these circumstances. We are requesting that you please waive the penalties and reinstate the corporation as soon as possible.
