The undersigned Incorporators to these Articles of Incorporation, natural persons competent to contract, hereby forms a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.



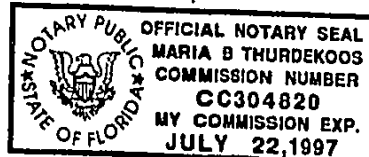
