**Article I**

**Name.** The name of this Corporation is BROWNWOOD, INC.

**Article II**

**Principal Office:** The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be: 2409 S.W. 13<sup>th</sup> Street, Gainesville, Florida, 32601, County of Alachua, State of Florida.

**Article III**

**Duration.** The period of duration of this Corporation shall be perpetual.

**Article IV**


Article VIII
