SOUTH ORLANDO, INC., a Florida corporation

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation is South Orlando, Inc., a Florida corporation.

To do everything necessary, proper, advisable, or convenient for the accomplishment of any of the purposes, or the attainment of any of the o'ojects, or the furtherance of any of the powers or purposes herein set forth, either alone or in association with others, incidental or pertaining to, or going out of, or connected with its business or purposes or powers, provided the same shall not be inconsistent with the laws of the State of Florida.
- 5. To indemnify any officer or director, or any former officer or director in the manner set out and provided for pursuant to the provisions of Section 607.0850 of the Florida Statutes, as amended.
- To do all acts necessary or reasonable to effectuate the provisions of the Bylaws of this Corporation.

ARTICLE X

The Corporation may be dissolved with the assent of not less than two-thirds (2/3) of the shareholders.
