

INCORPORATION OF

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act, adopt the following articles of incorporation:

ARTICLE ONE

NAME

The name of the corporation is SASHIE, INC.

ARTICLE TWO

PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The street address and mailing address of the initial principal office of the corporation are 2156 C White Pine Circle, West Palm Beach, Florida 33415.

ARTICLE THREE

CORPORATE DURATION

The duration of the corporation is perpetual.

PURPOSE OR PURPOSES




