ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation for profit under the laws of Florida, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

NAME AND PLACE OF BUSINESS

Section 1.1 Name and Place of Business. The name of this corporation is Hermelee, Stieglitz & Sharp, P.A., with its principal place of business at 200 North Laura Street, Jacksonville, Florida 32202.

ARTICLE II

DURATION

Section 2.1 <u>Duration</u>. This corporation shall exist perpetually. Corporate existence shall commence on the date these Articles are executed and acknowledged, except that if they are not filed by the Department of State of Florida within five days, exclusive of legal holidays, after they are executed and acknowledged, corporate existence shall commence upon filing by the Department of State.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSES

Section 3.1 <u>Purposes</u>. This corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any or all lawful business permitted under the laws of the United States and of the State of Florida. To Practice Law.

This right may also be waived by written waiver submitted by the shareholder to the corporation within sixty days of receiving said notice from the corporation.

Section 4.4 <u>Issuance of Stock</u>. No capital stock of this corporation shall be issued without either the unanimous written consent of the members of the board of directors or the written consent of the holders of not less than 51% of all issued shares of capital stock of the corporation, with such consent stating the price and terms to be paid for such stock.
