The undersigned, desiring to form a corporation for profit pursuant to the provision of the corporate laws of the State of Florida, does/ do hereby make, sign, acknowledge and file these articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the proposed corporation is:

LAWCO, INC.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

This corporation is specifically authorized and empowered to conduct business as follows:

- A. The specific business in which the corporation is primarily to engage is the operation of a business to provide management of professional offices and to provide professional office services.
- B. The general purposes, objects and powers of the corporation are to engage generally in any or all lawful activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States, the State of Florida or any other state, country, territory, or nation.
 - C. The corporation shall have the power to:
