ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

P & L ENGINEERING, INC.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation is P & L ENGINEERING, INC.

ARTICLE TWO

The duration of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE THREE

The general purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

- To conduct business normal to the operation of a small sales and service company related to Computers and computer related parts and equipment.
- 2. To transact any other lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Florida General Corporation Act or engage in any other trade or business which can, in the opinion of the board of directors of the corporation, be advantageously carried on in connection with or auxiliary to the foregoing business.



3. To do such other things as are incidental to the foregoing or necessary or desirable in order to accomplish the foregoing.
