ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

The undersigned hereby makes and subscribes these Articles of Incorporation intending to form a corporation under the provisions of the Florida Business Corporation Act Chapter 607 Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be: GulfCoast Business Telephone Systems, Inc.

ARTICLE II

(1) The general nature of the business of this corporation is selling and servicing of telephone systems.

(2) The corporation may engage in any activity of business permitted under the laws of the United States and of the State of Florida. While engaging in such activity or business, it may exercise all of the powers and privileges conferred by chapter 607, Florida Statutes, as presently in effect and as it may be amended from time to time in the future.

ARTICLE III

(1) The principal place of business shall be 6107 E5 Memorial Highway, Tampa, FL 33615.

(2) The mailing address of this corporation shall be 4558 S.W. 35th Street, Suite 100, Orlando, FL 32811

ARTICLE IV

The capital stock of the corporation will consist of 100 shares of common stock, par value of \$1.00 per share.

ARTICLE V

The corporation will begin business with capital of not less than One hundred dollars (\$100).

ARTICLE VI

Corporate existence shall begin at the time of subscription and acknowledgment. The corporation is to have perpetual existence unless dissolved by law.

The following provisions are inserted for the regulation of the business and for the conduct of the affairs of the corporation:



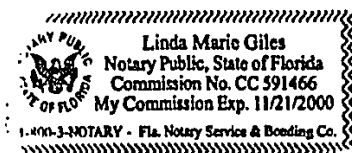


