ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLE XII.-BYLAWS

(a) sells, transfers, hypothecates or pledges, or attempts to sell, transfer, hypothecate or pledge any shares of this corporation to any person ineligible by law or by virtue of these Articles of Incorporation, the corporation's bylaws or shareholders agreements to be a shareholder in this corporation, or if such sale, transfer, hypothecation or pledge or attempt to sell, transfer, hypothecate or pledge is made in a manner prohibited by law or in a manner inconsistent with the provisions of these Articles of Incorporation, the bylaws of this corporation or shareholder agreements, or

(b) suffers an execution to be levied upon his shares or such shares are subjected to sale or other process, the effect of which is to vest any legal or equitable interest in such shares in some person other than the shareholder; then the shares of such shareholder shall immediately stand forfeited and such shares shall be immediately canceled by this corporation and the shareholder or other person in possession of such shares shall be entitled only to receive payment for the value of such shares which, in the absence of bylaw provision or written agreement among its shareholders, shall be the book value thereof as of the last day preceding the month in which any of the events enumerated above occurs. The shareholder whose shares become so forfeited and are so canceled by the corporation shall forthwith cease to be a shareholder and, except to receive payment for his shares in accordance with the forgoing and payment of any other sums then lawfully due and owing to said shareholder by the corporation, such shareholder shall then and thereafter have no further financial interest of any kind in the corporation.

ARTICLE XVI - INDEMNIFICATION

This corporation shall indemnify every person who is or was threatened to be made a party to any action, suit or proceeding, whether civil, criminal, administrative or investigative by reason of the fact that he or she is or was a director, officer or incorporator of this corporation against expenses (including attorneys fees), judgments, fines and amounts paid in settlement, actually and reasonable incurred by him or her in connection with such action, suit or proceeding, (except in cases involving gross negligence or willful misconduct in the performance of his or her duties), to the full extent permitted by applicable law.
