ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

The undersigned subscribers to the Articles of Incorporation of RIVER ROAD TRUCKING II, INC., natural persons competent to contract, hereby form a corporation for profit under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I.

NAME

The name of the corporation is RIVER ROAD TRUCKING II, INC.

ARTICLE II.

NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general character or nature of the business to be to be transacted by this corporation is:

(a) To operate commercial trucking company, and to engage in the general business associated with trucking companies, including, but not limited to, transporting and hauling various commodities, products or materials.

(b) To acquire by purchase, lease or other wise, lands and interests in lands, and to own, hold, improve, develop and manage any real estate so acquired, and to erect, or cause to be erected, on any lands owned, held or occupied by the corporation, buildings or other structures, now or hereafter erected on any lands so owned, held or occupied, and to encumber or dispose of any lands, or interests in lands, and any buildings or other structures, at any time owned or held by the corporation. To buy, sell, mortgage, exchange, lease hold for investment or otherwise, use and operate, real estate of all kinds, improved or unimproved, and any right or interest therein.

equipment, furnishing, improvement, development or management of any property, real or personal, at any time owned, held, or occupied by the corporation, and to invest, trade, and deal in any personal property deemed beneficial to the corporation and to lease, rent, encumber or dispose of any personal property at any time owned or held by the corporation.

(d) To contract debts and borrow money, issue and sell or pledge bonds, debentures, notes and other evidences of indebtedness, and execute such mortgages, transfers of corporate property, or other instruments to secure the payment of corporate indebtedness as required.

(e) To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts and agreements of every kind, for any lawful purpose, without limit as to amount, with any person, firm, association or corporation; and to transact any further and other business necessarily connected with the purposes of this corporation or calculated to facilitate the same.

(f) To carry on any or all of it's operations and businesses and to promote it's objects within the State of Florida or elsewhere, without restrictions as to place or amount; and to have, use, exercise and enjoy all of the general powers of like corporations.

(g) To engage in any and all lawful businesses, trades, occupations and professions.

ARTICLE III.

CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares of stock that this corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any time is One Thousand (1000) shares of common stock, each share having a par value of Five (\$5.00) Dollars.

Authorized capital stock may be paid for in cash, services, or property, at a just value to be fixed by the Board of

ARTICLE IV.

INITIAL CAPITAL

The amount of the capital with which this corporation shall begin business is Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars.

ARTICLE V.

TERM OF EXISTENCE

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE VI.

ADDRESS & REGISTERED AGENT

The initial street address of the principal office of the corporation is to be at Rt. 2, Box 148, Altha, Florida 32421. The initial registered agent for the corporation is designated as Stewart E. Parsons, Attorney at Law, 119 W. Washington Street, Chattahoochee, Florida. The Board of Directors may from time to time designate such other address and place for the principal office of this corporation, and may designate such other person to serve as registered agent, as it may see fit.

ARTICLE VII.

DIRECTORS

The corporation shall have one director initially. The number of directors may be increased or diminished from time to time by the By-laws.

ARTICLE VIII.

ARTICLE XI.

AMENDMENTS

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended in the manner provided by law. Every amendment shall be approved by the Board of Directors, proposed by them to the Stockholders and approved at a stockholders meeting by a majority of the stock entitled to vote thereon, unless all the directors and all the stockholders sign a written statement manifesting their intention that a certain amendment of these Articles of Incorporation be made.

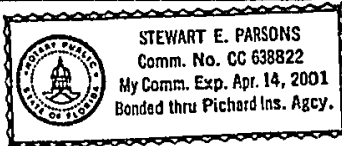
