

Mr. Bienz who is the only shareholder in the S Corporation JCJ Ventures of the Palm Beaches, Inc, did not received the paperwork from your office in order to allow him to complete and mail in the annual registration for this corporation in a timely manner. After realizing that he had not received the necessary papers, he remembered having received the enclosed letter. He then asked me to call the Department of State and explain the situation. I was told at that time that I should obtain a copy of the letter and send that to Tallahassee and this would be the proof that a problem with mail reception had been ongoing for some time. Since Mr. Bienz could not locate his original letter, he contacted the Postal Inspection Service in order to acquire an additional copy. Now that we have the copy we are mailing it to you along with a check for \$ 150.00 as I was instructed by your office previously.

RE: MAILBOX VANDALISM

There have recently been complaints of mailbox damage and tampering with mail matter, in the area in which you reside.

Damaging a mailbox and tampering with the mail is a serious crime. In most of these instances, we have found that children in the neighborhood are usually responsible. I am asking for the cooperation of the parents in the neighborhood to explain the seriousness of this problem to their children, in hopes that the problem will cease.

This is in no way inferring that your child has been involved in destruction of mailboxes or mail matter. This is being sent to all parents in your area.

As information, destruction of mailboxes and the theft of mail is a felony, punishable by up to five years in a federal prison and a \$250,000 fine, on each letter or mailbox stolen or destroyed.

If you see anyone stealing or tampering with the mail or mailboxes not belonging to them, please contact this office at 561/ 659-0261, or your local police department. All information will be held in strict confidence.

If you were mailing or expecting any checks or credit cards, please contact the companies, informing them of the situation. If the credit cards and/or checks were negotiated, please inform this office. ***As a reminder, mail should not be left in your mailbox for carrier pickup on weekends, holidays or evenings.***

Your cooperation and attention is appreciated.
