**ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT  
TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF  
INTERNATIONAL BID SERVICE, INC.**

1. The Articles of Incorporation of INTERNATIONAL BID SERVICE, INC., a Florida corporation, are hereby amended to change Article IV to read as follows:

ARTICLE IV - CAPITAL STOCK


The maximum number of shares of stock that this corporation is authorized to issue and have outstanding at any one time is 5,000 shares of common stock having a par value of \$1.00 per share.
