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
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of the stockholders sign a written statement manifesting their intention that a certain amendment of these articles of Incorporation be made.



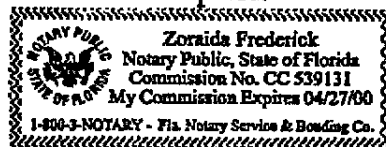
