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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

SUNTECH HOLDINGS, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I

EFFECTIVE DATE

The name of the corporation is SUNTECH HOLDINGS, INC.. whose principal place of business is 1115 SW 12th Terrace, Deerfield Beach, Florida 33441.

ARTICLE II

The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III

The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are to engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and of this State.

ARTICLE IV

The corporation shall have the authority to issue one thousand (1,000) shares of Class A Common Stock, with a par value of \$1.00 per share. The holders of Class A Common Stock shall not be entitled to vote but shall be entitled to receive the net assets of the corporation upon dissolution. The corporation shall also have the authority to issue one hundred (100) shares of Class B Common Stock, with a par value of \$1.00 per share.
