ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF COMPUTER COOPERATIVE COMPANY, INC.



ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be COMPUTER COOPERATIVE COMPANY, INC. The mailing address for the corporation is 2033 Main Street, Suite 403, Sarasota, Florida 34237.

ARTICLE II - DURATION

ARTICLE X - REPLACING STOCK CERTIFICATES
