

ARTICLES of INCORPORATION of Washington Oaks Publishing, Inc.

SEUNE PANT OF STATE TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act hereby adopt the following articles of incorporation.

Article I - Name

The name of the corporation is Washington Oaks Publishing, Inc.

Article II - Duration

The term of existence of the corporation is perpetual, beginning January 1, 1998.
