The undersigned, acting as the Sole Incorporator of the Corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such Corporation:

FIRST

The name of the Corporation is:

The period of duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual.

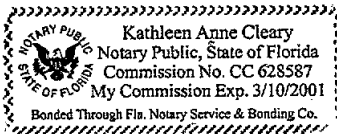
