In June of 1998, we received a Second Notice indicating that a \$550.00 fee was due for the filing of our Annual Report. We immediately contacted someone in your office by the name of Tom, and explained to him that we had not received the First Notice, as we had moved our offices, and somehow it must have gone astray. Tom told Leisha Pallett, our administrative assistant at that time, that she should send a check in the amount of \$150.00, and that it would be taken care of, which she did.

However, the check was apparently returned to that same office from which we moved. By the time we realized that this had still not been attended to, Ms. Pallett (of our office) had left our employ. Unfortunately no one knew that this matter had not been resolved until very recently, when it was brought to our attention.

I called the Division of Corporations, explaining the situation by telephone, and was told we had to complete a Reinstatement form. According to the list of fees on the back of the form, we are now responsible to pay \$750.00. We would like your assistance in this matter, and request that you look into our file to see what activity took place regarding this issue. It seems unfair that when Ms. Pallett spoke to Tom at your office, he confirmed that we needed to only submit \$150.00. However, when this was done, it was rejected. (Please refer to Ms. Pallett's letter to Tom dated July 2, 1998, a copy of which is attached.) We feel we had made every effort to resolve this matter months ago, and are now being penalized.
