

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF
DUPUIS - FLORIDA ASSOCIATES, INC.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation for profit under the laws of Florida, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article I

Name and Principal Office

Section 1.1. Name. The name of the corporation is DUPUIS - FLORIDA ASSOCIATES, INC.

Section 1.2. Principal Office. The street address and mailing address of the principal office of the corporation is 6620 Southpoint Dr. S., #300, Jacksonville, Florida 32216.

Article II

Duration

Section 2.1. Duration. This corporation shall exist perpetually. Corporate existence shall commence on the date these Articles of Incorporation are executed and acknowledged, except that if they are not filed by the Department of State of Florida within five business days, after they are executed and acknowledged, corporate existence shall commence upon filing by the Department of State.

Article III

Purposes

Capital Stock

- Section 4.1. Authorized Capital.
