ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

The undersigned incorporator to these Articles of Incorporation, a natural person, competent to contract, hereby presents these Articles of Incorporation for the formation of a corporation under the applicable laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The Name of this corporation shall be Tampa Turbine Group Inc.

ARTICLE II - NATURE OF BUSINESS

The corporation may engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States of America and the State of Florida.

ARTICLE III - COMMON STOCK

ARTICLE VIII - INFORMAL SHAREHOLDER ACTION

Any action of the shareholders may be taken without a meeting if consented in writing, setting forth the action so taken, shall be signed by all persons who would be entitled to vote upon such action at a meeting and filed with the secretary of the corporation as part of the corporate records.

ARTICLE IX - STOCK TRANSFER RESTRICTIONS

If all, or any of the shareholders or subscribers to stock of the corporation shall enter into any agreement among themselves or with the corporation or third persons, abridging, limiting, restricting, or changing the rights or interest of any one or more of the shareholders or subscribers to sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge, hypothecate, or transfer on the books of the corporation, any and all of the stocks of the corporation held by them, and if a copy of the agreement is filed with the corporation, all certificates of shares subject to such agreement or restriction shall have a reference thereto endorsed thereon by an officer of the corporation and such stock shall not thereafter be transferred on the books of the corporation except in accordance with the terms and provisions of the agreement. No contract, act or transaction of the corporation with any person or persons, firm or

corporation, in the absence of fraud, shall be affected, or invalidated by the fact that any officer or officers, director or directors of the corporation is a party to, or are the parties to, or interested in such contract, act or transaction, or in any way connected with such person or persons, firm or corporation and each and every person who may become a director or an officer of the corporation is hereby relieved from any liability that might otherwise exist from thus contracting with the corporation for the benefit of himself or any firm, association or corporation in which he may be in anywise interested.

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ARTICLE XIV - BY-LAWS

The power to adopt, alter, amend or repeal bylaws shall be vested in the Board of Directors and the shareholders.

ARTICLE XV - LONG TERM EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT

The Board of Directors may authorize the corporation to enter into employment contracts with any executive officer for a period longer than one year, and any charter or bylaw provision for annual election shall be without prejudice to the contract rights, if any, of the executive officer under such contracts.

ARTICLE XVI

DIRECTORS RELIANCE ON CORPORATE RECORDS

A director shall not be liable for dividends illegally declared, distributions illegally made to shareholders, or any other action taken in reliance in good faith upon financial statements of the corporation represented to him to be correct by the President of the corporation or the officer having charge of the books of account, or certified by an independent or certified accountant to clearly reflect the financial condition of the corporation; nor shall he be liable if in good faith determining the amount available for dividends or distribution he considers assets to be of ample value.
