THE UNDERSIGNED, acting as incorporator of a corporation pursuant to chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

- 3. To erect and maintain a building or buildings for the above purpose and to engage in any operation incidental to and essential to carry out the purposes above mentioned.
- 4. To solicit funds and donations in kind and from time to time to further the purposes of this corporation.
- 5. To acquire and receive by purchase, donation or otherwise, any property, real, personal or mixed, and to hold, use and dispose of the same.
- 6. To borrow money and to issue evidences of indebtedness in furtherance of any or all of the objects of its business; and to secure Loans by mortgage, pledge, deed of trust, or other lien.
