The undersigned subscriber (s) to these Articles of Incorporation, each a natural person competent to contract, hereby associate themselves together to form a corporation under the Laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE 1. - NAME

The name of this corporation is:

ARTICLE 11.- NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation shall be:

- (a) To engage in the professional function of providing bookkeeping, accounting, management services, as well as, a comprehensive tax filing system relating to the federal & state tax laws & to engage in any & all functions, services, and/or activities considered necessary, incidental, proper and/or ancillary, thereto, & to do all other things which may be desirable to achieve the purposes aforesaid and to operate a successful business.
- (b) To manufacture, purchase or otherwise acquire and to own, mortgage, pledge, sell, assign, transfer or otherwise dispose of, and to invest in, trade in, deal in and with goods, wares, merchandise, real and personal property, and services of every class, kind and description.


