ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

ISLAND CYCLE MOTOR COMPANY, INC.

SECRETARY PM 4:20 I, the undersigned, in order to form a corporation under ar pursuant to the provisions of the Laws of Florida for the purposes set forth below, hereby subscribe to these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be ISLAND CYCLE MOTOR COMPANY, INC.

ARTICLE II

The purpose and general nature of the business to be conducted and transacted by the corporation shall be as follows:

- To do and transact any and all business as permitted under the laws of the State of Florida and the United States of America.
- To purchase for investment and resale, and to traffic in land, property, houses and buildings and other property of any To create, sell and deal in freehold and leasehold ground rents. To make advances upon the security of land or houses or other property. To deal in any manner with real and personal property.
- To draw, make, accept, endorse, discount, execute, and issue promissory notes, bills of exchange, and other negotiable instruments, including bonds, debentures, or other obligations of this corporation, whether secured by mortgage pledge, or otherwise, or unsecured, for money borrowed, or in payment for property purchased or acquired, or for other lawful objects.
- D. To guarantee, purchase, hold, sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge or otherwise dispose of the shares of capital or any bonds, securities, or other evidences of indebtedness, created by any corporation and while owner of such stock or evidence of indebtedness, to exercise all of the rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote according to the rights of said instruments and agreements.
- To purchase, hold, sell and transfer shares of its own capital stock; subject, however, to such limitations as may be provided by law; and provided further, that shares of its own capital stock owned by the corporation shall not be voted upon

directly or indirectly nor counted as outstanding for the purpose of any stockholder's quorum or vote.
