

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation is ABLE CONTRACTORS, INC.

ARTICLE II - DURATION

The duration of this corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

This corporation is organized for the purpose of owning, operating, managing and maintaining a business providing restoration to churches and/or other historical buildings and for any and all other lawful businesses.

ARTICLE IV - CAPITAL STOCK

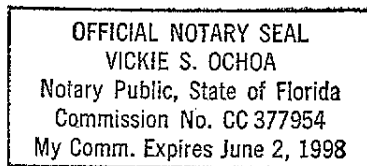
