**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
BRANDON FAMILY DENTAL CARE ASSOCIATES, P.A.**

THE UNDERSIGNED Natural person, who is licensed or otherwise legally authorized to practice the profession of dentistry in the State of Florida, for the purpose of forming a professional corporation in accordance with the Florida Professional Service Corporation Act, Chapter 621, Florida Statutes, hereby adopts the following articles of incorporation for such corporation:

**ARTICLE I.
NAME**

The name of the corporation is:

Brandon Family Dental Care Associates, P.A.

**ARTICLE II.
DURATION**

The corporation shall have perpetual existence commencing on February 1, 1998

**ARTICLE III.
PURPOSES**

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is to engage in the practice of dentistry; to treat; to prescribe; to diagnose; or to operate for any disease, pain, injury, deficiency, deformity, or physical condition of the human teeth, gums, jaws, and adjacent tissues; to furnish, construct, reproduce, or repair prosthetic dentures or bridges to be used and worn as substitutes for natural teeth; and to supply, repair, or construct orthodontic or various appliances used for the correction of malocclusion or deformities of other structures; to own and operate a dentist office; and to engage in related activities.

**ARTICLE IV.
CAPITAL STOCK**

- (a) The corporation is authorized to issue 1,000 shares of \$.10 par value common stock.
- (b) Shares may only be issued to, held by, or transferred to a person who is licensed to practice dentistry in the State of Florida or who is otherwise eligible to be a shareholder under the Florida Professional Corporation Act.

**ARTICLE V.
QUORUM FOR STOCKHOLDERS MEETINGS**

Unless otherwise provided for in the Corporation's bylaws, a majority of the shares entitled to vote, represented in person or by proxy, shall be required to constitute a quorum at a meeting of shareholders.
