The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corparation profit pursuant to Chapter 607, Florida Statutes, does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I. CORPORATE NAME

The name of this corporation is: Electronic Time and Attendance, incorporated.

ARTICLE II. PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND MAILING ADDRESS

The principal office of this corporation, which is also the mailing address of the corporation, is 1640 Plantation Oaks Lane, Amelia Island, FL 32034.

ARTICLE III. DURATION

This corporation shall have perpetual existence commencing on the date of the filing of these Articles of Incorporation with the Department of State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV. PURPOSES

This corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any and all lawful business.

ARTICLE V. CAPITAL STOCK

This corporation is authorized to issue 7,500 shares of \$1.00 par value common stock.
