ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

FORTY EIGHTY ONE HOLDINGS, INC.

SORTH TO THE OWNER OF THE PARTY The undersigned, acting as the sole Incorporator of a corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

ARTICLE I - NAME
