ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

PAIN MANAGEMENT AND REHABILITATION SPECIALIST, INC.

TALLARASSIEE FINALE The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be PAIN MANAGEMENT AND REHABILITATION SPECIALIST, INC.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSES

The purposes for which the corporation is organized is to transact any or all lawful business for which corporations may be organized under the Florida Business Corporation Act.

ARTICLE III - AUTHORIZED SHARES
