Regarding this report:

I was dismayed to receive a "second notice" calling for a payment of \$550 for filing. I have no record whatsoever of receiving a first notice.

I phoned the Florida Division of Corporations and was told that some consideration of my situation would be possible if I enclosed a check for the "on-time" payment amount of \$150 and wrote an accompanying letter of explanation.

I can assure you that I would most certainly have paid this filing fee on a first notice had I received the paperwork. There is no chance that I would have risked a \$400 penalty had I been able to foresee this problem.

I'm sure that excuses may be common but I should point out that mail in this building does not always reach its destination if it is too large to be put in letter-sized mail-boxes. Because this is an old building, larger mailings are placed in a hamper which all residents of a floor have access to. (In fact I received two "second-notices" from your department. One was "mishthrown" mail which should have been sent to a company in unit 102 on the first floor...a company called something like "First Impressions" or "Meeting Impressions". I redirected that envelope to the first floor hamper and hope the corporate officer found it.)

I must stress to you that a \$400 penalty is a severe hardship for a small, one-person business operated out of my bedroom. I would be most grateful if you would consider the fact that I am acting in good faith and any lateness on my part is absolutely not intentional. Punishment should fit the crime and I fear that a \$400 penalty will have a much harsher effect on me than you can imagine.

I am grateful to your operator for suggesting this remedy and I thank you in advance for your kind and fair consideration.
