ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

<u>OF</u>

BOOKS & OLD STUFF, INC.



The undersigned incorporator, pursuant to the Florida General Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation is: BOOKS & OLD STUFF, INC.

ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND MAILING ADDRESS

The principal office and mailing address of the Corporation is: 2841 Pottsburg Landing Court, Jacksonville, Florida, 32216.

ARTICLE III - CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares that the corporation is authorized to issue and have outstanding at any time is 1,000 shares of common stock par value \$1.00 per share.

ARTICLE IV - CUMULATIVE VOTING

At all times, each holder of common stock of the corporation shall be entitled to one (1) vote for each share of such stock standing in his name on the books of the corporation. At all elections of directors of the corporation, each holder of common stock shall be entitled to as many votes as shall equal the number of votes which (except for this provision) he would then be entitled to cast for the

election of directors with respect to his shares multiplied by the number of directors upon whose election he is then entitled to vote, and he may cast all of such votes for a single candidate or he may distribute them among some or all of the candidates.

ARTICLE V - PREEMPTIVE RIGHTS

Each shareholder, upon the sale for cash of any new stock of this corporation of the same kind, class or series as that which he already holds, shall have the right to purchase his pro rata share thereof (as nearly as may be done without the issuance of fractional shares) at the price at which it is offered to others. If this preemptive right is not exercised within thirty (30) days of receipt of a notice in writing from the corporation by purchase for cash, this right shall be deemed waived.
