

To Whom it May Concern:

I was shocked to receive the Notice of Administrative Dissolution or Revocation in the mail this week and I am writing to plead that your office reinstates our S-Corp without the \$700 required fee for the circumstances I've outlined below.

My business partner and I operate our business out of a 1-room office subleased from RE/MAX, a large real estate company in the area. Many times we have had our mail returned "addressee unknown" because it is addressed to Brevard Design Associates and not RE/MAX. As we are the only sub-lease, the office is not set up with separate suite assignments.


We have discovered that there has been two separate occasions in which bank statements and a business check were returned to the sender when it was addressed to Brevard Design Associates, despite the fact that we receive mail here every day. We had bank statements returned in March and April of 2000 and the business check returned as "addressee unknown" in August of 2000. We made contact with the post office in Rockledge after the first incident in April and we were told that the postman was not aware that Brevard Design Associates was our D.B.A. for our corporation Stephen R. McCaslin, P.A.

All was well until a customer mailed us a check which was returned to them "addressee unknown". I do not why this keeps happening and when we contacted the post office they say we have to give them a copy of the returned mail to prove the mail was being returned. We tried to get the returned notices from Bank of America but the Tampa office said they do not keep them. Our customer who mail us the returned check said he threw the envelope away. If you have received the notices back in the mail, I can take them to the post office as proof of their mistakes. Meanwhile, since these other incidents have occurred, I can only surmise that the notices of renewal were also returned to your offices undelivered as "addressee unknown."


We are a small, 2-employee, company struggling to build our business. We do not want to dissolve our business and do not have \$700 to reinstate at this late date. In light of the above mail interruptions, can you please accept my check for \$150 and reinstate our corporation?
