## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act, does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article 1. NAME. The name of the corporation is: GRAY'S FLOOR SERVICE, INC.

Article 2. DURATION. The duration of the corporation is perpetual.

Article 3. PURPOSE.
