PREAMBLE

We, the undersigned Subscribers, natural persons, competent to contract, do hereby associate ourselves under the following Articles of Incorporation, and form a Corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I
NAME

The name of the Corporation shall be **VINTAGE HOLDINGS, INC.**

ARTICLE II
PRINCIPAL ADDRESS AND MAILING ADDRESS

The principal address of the Corporation is **7451 Oakboro Drive, Lake Worth, Florida 33467**, and the mailing address of the Corporation is **7451 Oakboro Drive, Lake Worth, Florida 33467**.

ARTICLE III
PURPOSES

The purpose for which the Corporation is formed and the business and objects to be carried on and promoted by it are:

To transact any or all lawful business for which Corporations may be incorporated under Chapter 607, Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE IV
TERM OF EXISTENCE

This Corporation shall exist perpetually beginning five (5) days prior to the date of filing of these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE V
REQUIRED CAPITAL

This Corporation shall begin business with capital of not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).

ARTICLE VI
CAPITAL STOCK

This Corporation shall be authorized to have outstanding at any one time a maximum of One Thousand Two Hundred (1,200) shares of Common Stock, having a par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share.

ARTICLE VII
DIRECTORS

REGISTERED AGENT AND OFFICE

The Registered Agent for this Corporation shall be **Josephine Stellino** and the Registered Office shall be located at **7451 Oakboro Drive, Lake Worth, Florida 33467**, or such other person or place as the Board of Directors shall from time to time direct, with appropriate notice being given to the Secretary of State in accordance with law.

ARTICLE X
SPECIAL PROVISIO

Any action by the Board of Directors of this Corporation which is within their power taken at a meeting of such Board of Directors shall be valid for all intents and purposes whether or not lawful notice of said meeting shall have been given to all Directors as required by law or by the By-Laws of this Corporation, if at any time prior to, during or subsequent to such meeting all Directors shall execute a Waiver of Notice of such meeting, in writing, and providing a majority of the Directors shall have approved or approve the action taken at such meeting.

When not prohibited by law, any action by the shareholders of this Corporation which is within their power taken at a meeting of such shareholders shall be valid for all intents and purposes whether or not lawful notice of said meeting shall have been given to all shareholders, as

required by law or by the By-Laws of this Corporation, if at any time prior to, during or subsequent to such meeting all shareholders shall execute a Waiver of Notice of such meeting in writing and providing a majority of the shareholders shall have approved or approve the action taken at such meeting.

When not prohibited by law, any action of the shareholders of this Corporation may be taken without a meeting if consent, in writing, setting forth the action so taken, shall be signed by all the persons who would be entitled to vote upon such action at a meeting and filed with the secretary of the Corporation as part of the corporate records. Members of the Board of Directors or any executive committee designated by the Board of Directors in accordance with the law shall be deemed present at any meeting of the Board of Directors or executive committee, as the case may be, if a conference telephone or similar communications equipment by means of which all persons participating in the meeting can hear and be heard by all other persons is used.

ARTICLE XII
INSPECTION OF BOOKS AND RECORDS

The Corporation shall from time to time determine whether and to what extent and at what time and place and under what condition and regulations the accounts and books of the Corporation (other than the stock book) or any of them shall be open to inspection of shareholders; and no shareholders shall have any right of inspecting any account, book or document of this Corporation except as conferred by statutes, unless authorized by a resolution of the shareholders or by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE XIII
AMENDMENT

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended in the manner and with the vote provided by law.

ARTICLE XIV
PRE-EMPTIVE RIGHTS

Every shareholder, upon the sale for cash of any new stock of this Corporation, shall have the right to purchase his pro-rata share thereof (as nearly as may be done without issuance of fractional shares) at the price at which it is offered to others.

ARTICLE XV
INDEMNIFICATION OF OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS




